INDICATIONS AND USAGE

Keep treatment sets refrigerated at 2-7°C. Do not freeze. Injections are administered subcutaneously using sterile needles and syringes.

NEVER INJECT INTRAVENOUSLY

Before injecting, withdraw the syringe plunger slightly. If blood appears in the syringe, reinsert in another site. The hyposensitization program may vary with each individual animal. The following injection schedule serves as a guideline. The actual dosage used should always be determined by the veterinarian.

HANDLING ADVERSE REACTIONS

Animals should be observed for at least 30 minutes following an injection. Possible systemic reactions to watch for are: Increased itching, vomiting and/or diarrhea and hives. The possibility of an anaphylactic reaction is remote. However, if such a reaction occurs, it may be advisable to administer epinephrine. For average size dog, inject 0.2 to 0.5 ml of epinephrine 1:1000 w/v. Mild reactions may be controlled with antihistamines.

ADMINISTERING TWO TREATMENT SETS TO ONE ANIMAL

Using the same schedule, administer the recommended volume for each set preferably at different subcutaneous sites on the animal.
