Information you want to gather for your Vet includes:

WHAT ARE THE SYMPTOMS? _____

Most common are redness, itching, chewing of paws, face rubbing, but can also include vomiting, diarrhea, etc.

WHEN DO THE REACTIONS OCCUR? Are they seasonal? Sporadic? Year round? _____

WHAT FOOD ARE YOU FEEDING YOUR PET? Include brand as well as the main ingredients: i.e. Chicken and Rice or Duck and Potato. _____

This should also include any table scraps. Include frequency and types of food.

IS YOUR PET CURRENTLY ON ANY MEDICATIONS? List any supplements, flea and tick medications, etc.

HOW OLD WAS YOUR PET WHEN YOU FIRST NOTICED SYMPTOMS? Let the Vet know how long this has been going on. _____
