



DROWSINESS:

APPEARANCE: sleeping more, sluggish.

BEHAVIOR: lethargic, sleeping more, unenthusiastic.

HYPERACTIVITY:

APPEARANCE: aggression, restlessness, anxiety.

BEHAVIOR: suddenly snapping, irritability, agitation, insomnia.

NAUSEA:

APPEARANCE: lethargic, sluggish.

BEHAVIOR: whiney, nervous, agitated, pacing.

DRY MOUTH:

APPEARANCE: depressed, mopes.

BEHAVIOR: increase water consumption, increase in urination.

LACK OF APPETITE:

APPEARANCE: lethargic, sluggish.

BEHAVIOR: indifference to food, reduction in appetite, weight loss.

CONSTIPATION:

APPEARANCE: distended belly, sluggish.

BEHAVIOR: decrease in appetite, difficulty urinating, lethargic.
